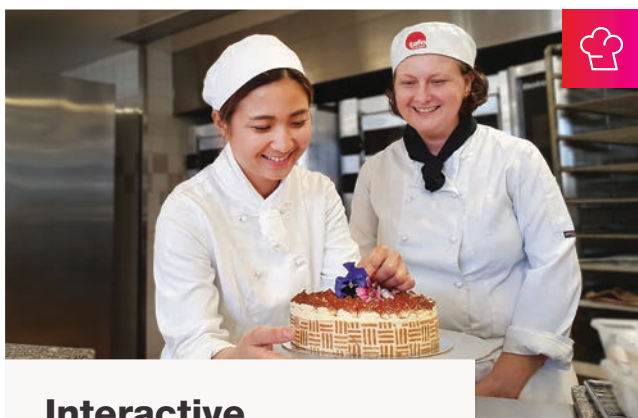
World-class facilities

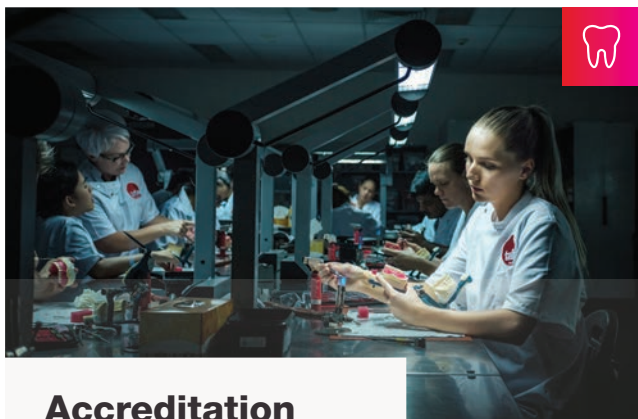

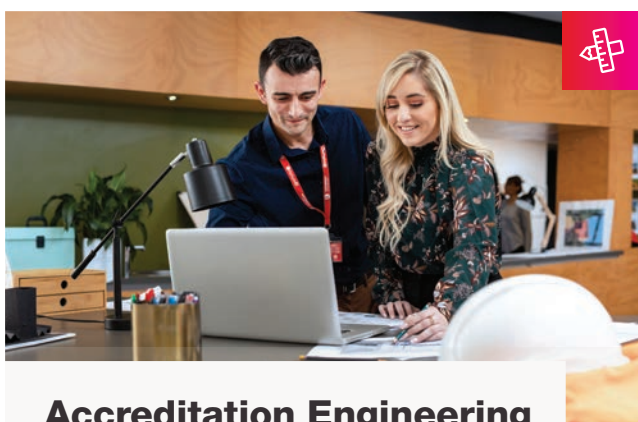
Accreditation dentals

The Benefits of Vocational Placement

One of the best things about studying with TAFE Queensland is that so many of our qualifications require students to participate in a vocational placement component, or “VPC” for short. In some countries, this is known as an “internship”.

Vocational placements provide students with the opportunity to apply the skills they learn on campus in a supervised, structured, “real-world” workplace environment.

Placements allow students to gain up to date industry level training “on the job” - while giving employers the opportunity to pass on their knowledge and increase the number of work-ready graduates.

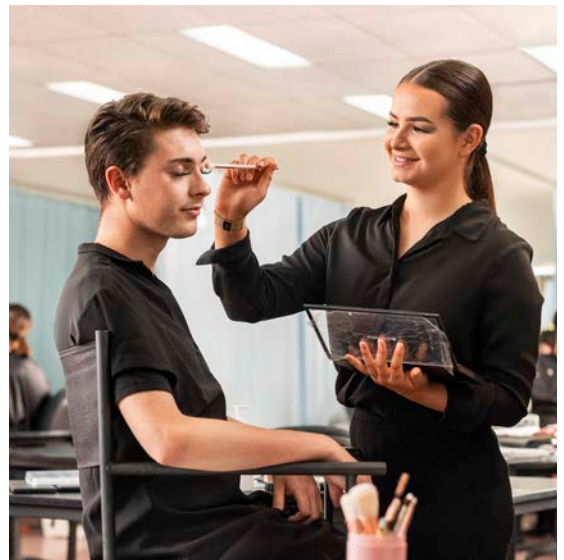
Do I have to do a placement?

Yes, the placement component forms part of your training and assessment for your course and is a mandatory requirement to achieve your qualification. Industry advisory committees in Australia have determined that as part of your course, you must be able to demonstrate your skills in the workplace whilst under supervision. TAFE Queensland has ensured that the placement is authorised under Australian and Queensland State law and you are covered by appropriate insurances.

What is the difference between a placement and work experience?

Whereas a placement is compulsory, work experience is offered or encouraged as an additional feature in some TAFE Queensland courses to help you gain important on-the-job skills that can help you get a better understanding about your chosen career and may lead to getting casual paid work. Work Experience (“WE”) is not part of your formal assessment and as the title suggests is not paid.

Our Pathways to University Guide details our diploma to degree articulation arrangements.

Our diploma to degree pathways will give you the best of both worlds, combining practical training from TAFE Queensland with the theoretical knowledge of a prestigious university degree.

Applying for a degree pathway is a 2-stage process involving an application to TAFE Queensland and a separate application to one of our partner universities.

NOTE: if you are applying through an education agent, your agent must be an approved agent of both TAFE Queensland and the University.

Fees and payment structure

International Price List

TAFE Queensland's Price List provides a quick reference to our course tuition fees, locations and start dates. It will also indicate if vocational placements and university pathways are available.

TAFE Queensland courses are paid by semester:

- 1 year course = 2 semesters / 2 payments
- 1.5 year course = 3 semesters / 3 payments
- 2 year course = 4 semesters / 4 payments

Example: Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care is 1.5 years. **Total cost: \$15,000 (has a total of 3 semesters / 3 payments).**

- You pay \$5,000 for Semester 1 (Jan 2021) less any deposit*;
- \$5000 for Semester 2 (July 2021);
- and final \$5000 for Semester 3 (Jan 2022).

How to pay

The available payment methods for new international students can be chosen from following options:



1. Go to tafeqld.flywire.com
2. Enter the country of origin to initiate your payment booking and click "Next"
3. Follow the instructions provided to send funds to Flywire. For debit/credit card payments, enter your card details online to complete your payment in your home currency
4. Receive SMS/text and email notifications each step of the way, including a confirmation when your payment has been delivered to TAFE Queensland.

You can also create a Flywire account to track your payment online 24x7.

1. Go to students.convera.com/tafeqld
2. Enter your student information
3. Enter the Australian dollar amount as listed on your offer letter
4. Select your preferred payment method — telegraphic transfer or credit card.

Convera will transfer your payment in full to TAFE Queensland in Australian dollars (AUD).

Accommodation options

TAFE Queensland has a range of student accommodation providers throughout Queensland*. Student accommodation gives you a great opportunity to meet fellow students while still having your own space.

Easy application process

1 Select a course and campus

Visit our website tafeqld.edu.au/international to view our courses for international students and select your preferred course and desired study location.

2 Check entry requirements

Check to see if you meet the Academic and English language requirements for your chosen course. We may be able to arrange an English pathway for you if you do not meet the requirements.

3 Complete your application

Depending on your nationality you may be able to apply directly online on our **How to Apply page**. Or you will need to use one of our approved TAFE Queensland **education agents (QR codes below)**. You will need as a minimum: a passport copy, academic records for senior school and any later study and, in most cases, a valid English test and Statement of Purpose.



Documents that are not in English must be translated.

4 Accept your Letter of Offer

If your application is successful you will receive a Letter of Offer, which may be conditional upon you meeting certain requirements (such as English language proficiency). Your Letter of Offer will show a breakdown of fees and payment dates for the courses you have chosen. It will also include important information about our refund policy and terms and conditions. If you are happy with your offer, you will need to sign your acceptance and return.

5 Arrange your first payment

Once you have accepted your Offer you will need to arrange your first payment (or deposit). This may include overseas student health cover (OSHC). Your Letter of Offer provides details of how to make this payment using one of our preferred services such as Western Union or Flywire. Once this has been received we will issue you an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE).

6 Apply for your student visa

Once you have your eCOE, you can apply for your student visa. TAFE Queensland does not arrange this for you. You or your agent will need to prepare this application. You should allow 4-6 weeks for your visa to be processed. Visit **Homeaffairs.gov.au** for more information.

- Basic Key Skills Builder (bksb) skills review
- Your digital, reading, writing and mathematic skills
- Succeeding in your course, whichever way you are studying
- Time management and preparing for exams
- Help with assignments, referencing and essay writing
- Studiosity: 24/7 on-demand, online study help for academic literacy skills and core subject support



Basic Key Skills Builder (bksb)

The bksb is an approved online skills review tool used by TAFE Queensland to determine your English and maths levels within the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF). We want to make sure you have the right skills and support to be successful in your course. The bksb helps us identify any areas where you may need additional support to help you achieve your goals. We recommend all new students undertake a bksb assessment before starting any training, for some courses this may be an entry requirement.



AccessAbility support

If you identify with having a disability, our staff can work with you to develop a support plan. This may include:

- Communicating with your teacher on your behalf, if required
- Providing sign language interpreters, readers and scribes
- Loaning you assistive technology
- Coordinating alternative assessment arrangements



Counselling support

English language requirements

There is a minimum level of English language skills that are required to study at TAFE Queensland for international students who do not speak English as their first language which is as follows:

Certificate III*, Certificate IV, Diploma* and Advanced Diploma

International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
Academic: Overall 5.5 (with no score lower than 5.0)

Associate degree level courses

International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
Academic: Overall 6.0 (Writing 6.0, all other skills no less than 5.5)

Bachelor level courses

International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
Academic: Overall 6.5 (with no score lower than 6.0)



*Notes:

- Please note: some courses may require higher or lower IELTS (Academic) than the minimum of IELTS 5.5 and/or include specific sub-score requirements.

The entry requirements for all our certificate III level courses is an Australian Year 10 qualification or equivalent. Entry to our certificate IV, diploma and advanced diploma courses requires a Year 12 qualification or equivalent.

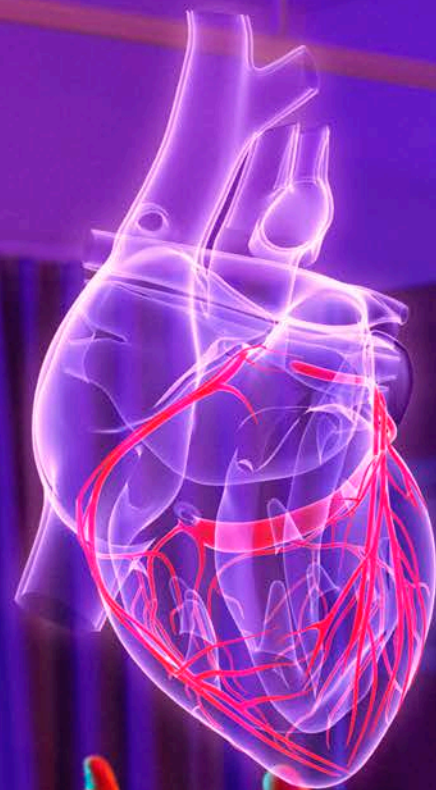

Certificate III in Accounts Administration / Certificate IV in Accounting and Bookkeeping / Diploma of Accounting FNS30322 / FNS40222 / FNS50222 | 110034H / 109980J / 112112E

Upgrade your qualifications in accounting and finance with this high-level dual qualification. This course will give you the essential knowledge and professional skills to work competently within the accounting, business, and finance sectors.
