





Vocational Placement

Vocational Placement is a mandatory unit included in some courses at TAFE Queensland. Students are required to undertake a set amount of supervised hours with a local business, relevant to their qualification.

The total amount of hours is determined by the qualification and can be found outlined in the <u>course</u> <u>information page</u>, listed under the important information section.

Students must successfully complete their vocational placement to be eligible to graduate from their qualification. Students may also hear other staff or students refer to vocational placement as the acronym VPC.

Vocational placement provides a great opportunity where students can utilise their skills and knowledge gained from their studies at TAFE Queensland in a real life working environment, under the supervision of industry experts.











Degree Pathways

If you are interested in studying a degree after your diploma studies, TAFE Queensland has partnerships with some of Australia's top universities and institutes of higher education so you can graduate job-ready, before starting your degree.

Our hands-on practical qualifications give you a head start so you can find work in your chosen field sooner, while you are studying your degree.

Completing a diploma at TAFE Queensland may give you credit into your first year of study. These credits are pre-negoiated for you by TAFE Queensland. You can access the full list of course information including: costs, location, intakes and study period, offered to international students on our website below.

TAFE Queensland courses are paid by semester:

- 1 year course = 2 semesters / 2 payments
- 1.5 year course = 3 semesters / 3 payments
- 2 year course = 4 semesters / 4 payments

Here is an example to show the breakdown of how fees are paid per semester.

For example, the Certificate III in Hairdressing (SHB30416 | 095203C) is 1.5 years in duration.

1.5 years has a total of 3 semesters (which is 3 payments).

Payment structure:

- Semester 1 \$5,500 (this cost does not include any OSHC)
- Semester 2 \$5,500
- Semester 3 \$5,500


Listen to our Podcast

- Basic Key Skills Builder (bksb) skills review
- your digital, reading, writing and mathematic skills
- succeeding in your course, whichever way you are studying
- time management and preparing for exams
- help with assignments, referencing and essay writing
- Studiosity: 24/7 on-demand, online study help for academic literacy skills and core subject support.



Basic Key Skills Builder (bksb)

The bksb is an approved online skills review tool used by TAFE Queensland to determine your English and maths levels within the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF). We want to make sure you have the right skills and support to be successful in your course. The bksb helps us identify any areas where you may need additional support to help you achieve your goals. We recommend all new students undertake a bksb assessment before starting any training, for some courses this may be an entry requirement.



AccessAbility support

If you identify with having a disability, our staff can work with you to develop a support plan. This may include:

- communicating with your teacher on your behalf, if required
- providing sign language interpreters, readers and scribes
- loaning you assistive technology
- coordinating alternative assessment arrangements.

Counselling support



Short-term counselling is available for all students. Support services include:

- deciding what career path to follow
- choosing the right course
- general difficulties with student life
- personal and complex issues
- cross-cultural and special needs
- service referrals for long-term support.

Many student accommodation providers have additional facilities and services such as common areas, social events, and after hours security.



Complete your application

Depending on your nationality you may be able to apply directly online on our How to Apply page. Or you will need to use one of our approved TAFE Queensland education agents (QR codes below). You will need as a minimum: a passport copy, academic records for senior school and any later study and, in most cases, a valid English test and Statement of Purpose.

Documents that are not in English must be translated.

Accept your Letter of Offer

If your application is successful you will receive a Letter of Offer, which may be conditional upon you meeting certain requirements (such as English language proficiency). Your Letter of Offer will show a breakdown of fees and payment dates for the course you have chosen. It will also include important information about our refund policy and terms and conditions. If you are happy with your offer, you will need to sign your acceptance and return.

Arrange your first payment

Once you have accepted your Offer you will need to arrange your first payment (or deposit) and any OSHC costs if TAFE Queensland is organising on your behalf. Your Letter of Offer provides details of how to make this payment, more information on payment options can be found here. Once this has been received we will issue you with an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE).

Apply for your student visa

Once you have your CoE, you can apply for your student visa. TAFE Queensland does not arrange this for you. Either yourself or your agent will need to prepare this application. Visit Homeaffairs.gov.au for more information on student visa processing times.

REGISTERED AGENTS

International students who are under 18 years of age and are applying for a student visa are required by the Australian Department of Home Affairs to have adequate welfare arrangements in place.



English language requirements

To study a course at TAFE Queensland, international students are required to have a minimum level of English language skills.

The level of English language required is dependent on the study area and course level. You can find more detailed information specific to your course, on our website, under the important information section:

Certificate III*, Certificate IV, Diploma* and Advanced Diploma

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic: Overall 6.0 (with no score lower than 5.5).

Associate degree level courses

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic: Overall 6.0 (Writing 6.0, all other skills no less than 5.5).

Bachelor level courses

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic: Overall 6.5 (with no score lower than 6.0).

* Please note: some courses may require a higher or lower IELTS (Academic) than the minimum of IELTS 6.0 and/or include specific sub-score requirements.

Nursing courses

To ensure success for our nursing courses, a higher IELTS is required for entry. Both the Diploma of Nursing and Bachelor of Nursing require a 7.0 overall with no bands lower than a 7.0, please check our website for more information.

English courses

If you are unable to meet the minimal level of English, TAFE Queensland offers a range of English Language courses that you can study, to help you pathway into your future course.

Please contact us for more information and your course options, or discuss these options with your agent.





Academic entry requirements

In addition to your English Language requirements, to study at TAFE Queensland you must also have the following academic equivalencies:

- certificate III level courses require a Year 10 qualification or equivalent
- certificate IV, diploma and advanced diploma courses require a Year 12 qualification or equivalent.

You can view what your country school requirements are, by clicking on the QR code below. This list will show you the academic equivalency that you will need to send with your application.

You will also need to check the course information online, as some courses require additional information for the application, for example, some creative courses require a portfolio to be submitted as well.

Certificate III in Accounts Administration FNS30322 | 110034H

This course will give you a practical understanding of the various roles within the finance sector. You'll gain a broad range of skills including writing simple documents, producing business documents, performing financial calculations, extracting interim reports, and administering subsidiary accounts and ledgers.

Certificate III in Accounts Administration / Certificate IV in Accounting and Bookkeeping / Diploma of Accounting FNS30322 / FNS40222 / FNS50222 | 110034H / 109980J / 112112E

Build your qualifications in accounting and finance with this pathway to high-level triple qualifications. This course will give you the essential knowledge and professional skills to work competently within the accounting, business, and finance sectors.

During this course you will develop from fundamental financial skills to an advanced understanding of financial reporting, budget management and forecasting, income tax returns, and providing accurate accounting advice.

Successful completion of this course meets the Tax Practitioners Board academic requirements for registration as a BAS agent (additional experience requirements apply).

Diploma of Business / Diploma of Leadership and Management BSB50120 / BSB50420 | 108530K/104562A

Throughout this course you will be mentored in team leadership and management, discover how to utilise emotional intelligence to maximise team outcomes, and learn how to develop and implement an operational plan to facilitate effective workplace practices. You will also cover topics including communicating with influence, project work, workforce planning management, and risk management.

Diploma of Business / Diploma of Marketing and Communication BSB50120 / BSB50620 | 108530K/108652M

This course will equip you with specialised knowledge in customer research, web design, and digital marketing and communications. You'll gain practical experience developing promotional programs and business and marketing plans. In addition, you will learn how to pitch advertising concepts, identify and exploit market opportunities, and understand consumer behaviour. You will also develop specialised knowledge in project work and workforce planning management.

Information technology

Certificate III in Information Technology ICT30120 | 106316K

Kick start your career in information and communications technology (ICT) with this entry-level qualification from TAFE Queensland. Get the hands-on skills for the role you want with both a foundation stream and range of specialised streams.

Streams include: Generalist IT Support, Cyber Security Awareness, Networking, Web Development.

Diploma of Information Technology (Advanced Networking and Cloud Engineering) ICT50220 | 107313E

You will have access to industry standard equipment and the opportunity to develop close industry contacts through our leading educators.

Diploma of Screen and Media - 3D Animation and Visual Effects stream CUA51020 | 107862J

This course will give you the intermediate skills required to work within this exciting and challenging sector.
