**Students are required to wear protective clothing and bring Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) on the first day and every day to TAFE.**

- **Protective clothing** – long cotton drill trousers, and short or long-sleeved cotton drill shirt
- **Eye protection** – must comply with AS1336 or AS1337
- **Protective footwear** – safety toe, leather upper, non-slip – must comply with AS2210
- **Hair protection** – peak cap with a snood capable of fully containing hair
- **Hand protection** – Mechanics Gloves - must comply with AS2161
- **Welding** – specific PPE for welding units will be discussed with delivery area at local orientation

Please note that the PPE listed above is **not supplied** by TAFE Queensland SkillsTech.

**IMPORTANT:** Students must be adequately clothed in accordance with occupational health and safety requirements. Students failing to meet these minimum standards of dress will not be permitted entry to classes and may need to be re-booked which will incur an additional fee.

Please be advised it is a requirement, prior to commencement of air-conditioning units, students **MUST** obtain a *Trainee Refrigerant Handling Licence*. Allow sufficient time to complete the application. Your teacher will advise how to proceed with licence application prior to commencement of these classes.

**Licence Application Details:**

- Your Confirmation of Enrolment is required to obtain a *Trainee Air Conditioning Licence* from the *Australian Refrigeration Council (ARC)*.
- **Cost is \$31 and payable directly to the Australian Refrigeration Council (ARC).**
- Students mostly apply for the ***CL000 Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Trainee Licence (Classroom)***. This licence is to handle refrigerant in a classroom setting only. The licensee cannot handle refrigerant outside the classroom setting. No other codes to be ticked.
- This licence is valid for a period of training which can be up to one year.
