Unique Student Identifier (USI)

From 1 January 2015, it is mandatory when undertaking nationally recognised training to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). Your USI account will contain all your nationally recognised training records and results.

It's important that we have a USI as under Commonwealth Government legislation, we cannot issue a qualification until it is recorded.

There are two ways to get a Unique Student Identifier:
