Inherent Requirements

Inherent requirements are the essential components of a Course or Unit/s of Study that demonstrate the abilities, knowledge and skills to achieve the core learning outcomes of the Course or Unit/s of Study. Inherent requirements are the fundamental parts of a Course that you must meet in order to complete your course and graduate.

The Australian Disability Clearinghouse on Education and Training (ADCET) states: The inherent or essential requirements are those that students must pass in order to complete a course/unit/program. They are those components, which if removed or substituted would substantially impact on the learning outcomes.

Inherent requirements are therefore essential in becoming a registered nurse and may be used to assess any conditions or disabilities and make reasonable adjustments. While on clinical placement, you will experience the same situations and tasks as a registered nurse, and some will require specific mental and physical skills and abilities. Please read the Inherent Requirements for Nursing Courses.

TAFE Queensland has obligations under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (Cth), the Anti-Discrimination Act 1991 (QLD) and the Disability Standards for Education 2005 (Cth) to ensure that reasonable adjustments are available. Reasonable adjustment is a term used in the education and employment sectors to refer to any modification made to the learning environment, certification requirements, educational delivery or assessment method to help learners with disability access and participate in education on the same basis as those without disability. An adjustment is reasonable if it balances the interests of all parties affected. TAFE Queensland cannot guarantee industry will be able to accommodate a student's specific support requirements or needs, for their individual circumstance.

Adjustments must be reasonable and cannot compromise the academic integrity of a course. Reasonable adjustments assist students in achieving the inherent requirements and are not a substitute for them. TAFE Queensland's capacity to accommodate eligible requests is subject to the availability of clinical placements provided to TAFE Queensland and or healthcare facility limitations. If inherent requirements cannot be met with reasonable adjustments by TAFE Queensland, we will provide alternative course options.

English Language Skills Requirements

To be considered for enrolment into an approved Bachelor of Nursing program, the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council (ANMAC) accreditation requires that you have met the English language skills requirements as outlined in the English language skills registration standard (2025) leading to initial registration with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA).

These requirements include a written declaration that English is your primary language or evidence of achievement of the minimum English language test result as specified as specified in the MMBA's Registration Standard: English Language Skills 2025.

This form will only need to be completed once, even if you change your course preferences. To study nursing at TAFE Queensland, you must demonstrate that your English language skills will enable you to practice your profession safely.

Registration as a nurse with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) is dependent on successful application to the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). To support your application, the NMBA may request evidence to demonstrate how you meet the English language skills requirements.

How do I meet the NMBA English Language Skills Requirements?

Current AHPRA Registration as an Enrolled Nurse: English language requirements will have been demonstrated for registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). Evidence of registration must be provided.

Or

English as your primary language: you must have attended and satisfactorily completed at least six (6) years of primary and secondary education taught and assessed solely in English. At least two years of this education must have been between grades 7 and 12.

This education must have been completed in one or more of the recognised countries:

Or

English is NOT your primary language: You will need to complete an approved English Language Proficiency Test as part of your application: IELTS (academic module), TOEFL iBT, PTE Academic or OET and achieve the minimum scores outlined in the NMBA's Registration Standard: English Language Skills March 2025.
