The Critical Minerals Hub (CMH) is one of the initiatives that will be developed by TAFE Queensland under the Queensland Government's REFF project. The CMH will involve the development of a specialised training hub in Mount Isa with comprehensive training materials and industry information on the growing critical minerals sector. This hub will include access to cutting-edge equipment such as operator simulators, and advanced computer-based training with virtual reality capability.

Project aim

To meet the evolving needs of the critical minerals industry, the CMH will be developed to:

- Empower communities through education
- Support long-term employment growth and retention
- Broaden the understanding of process equipment
- Provide trainers with industry currency to enable the upskilling of the workforce.

Deliverables

- Establish a Critical Minerals Training Hub in Mount Isa with comprehensive training materials and industry information
- Developing specialised course content and upskilling staff to meet the evolving needs of the critical minerals industry
- Allocate resources for the development of educational content and the upskilling of trainers to cater to the growing demand for a broader understanding of process equipment in the sectors

Delivery

The CMH will provide participants access to cutting-edge equipment such as operator simulators, and advanced computer-based training tools with virtual reality capability.

As well as the development of the CMH, a range of specialised course content, including micro-credentials, train the trainer materials and nationally accredited units of competency will be developed as part of this training initiative
