Project overview

The Renewable Energy Training Hubs (RETHs) is one of the initiatives that will be developed by TAFE Queensland under the REFF project. The RETHs include the development of specialised training hubs in Toowoomba, Kingaroy and Mount Isa. These hubs will be used to deliver specific training and education in support of Queensland's growing renewable energy industry in these regions.

Project aim

To support the growing demand for electrotechnology and green energy related training, the RETHs will be developed with the aim of:

- Providing specialised training in renewable energy technologies and ensuring the developed of a skilled workforce that can contribute to and bolster the existing regional supply chains
- Facilitating skills development in energy storage systems and data analysis
- Supporting long-term employment growth and retention.

Deliverables

- Establish RETHs in Toowoomba, Kingaroy and Mount Isa, to cater to the growing demand for specialised training in solar, and wind technologies while facilitating skills development in energy storage systems and data analysis
- Procure and develop new equipment and learning products to support renewable energy skills development
- Developing specialised course content in new and emerging areas such as green energy, solar and wind.

Delivery

The RETHs will provide participants access to cutting-edge equipment to encourage skill development across many different areas including battery energy storage systems, electrotechnology, green energy, energy auditing techniques and data analysis.

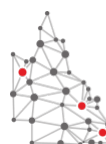
As well as the development of the hubs, a range of specialised course content, including micro-credentials, train the trainer materials and nationally accredited units of competency will be developed as part of this training initiative.
