## Project overview

The Renewable Pathways Initiative (RPI) is one of the projects that will be developed by TAFE Queensland under the Queensland Government's REFF Project. The initiative will see the identification and development of pathways that will support workers to transition into the renewable energy sector.

This program will include the engagement of a Renewable Energy Transition Training Officer for the delivery of a renewable training pilot program within the Banana Shire using the mobile renewable energy training facility.

## Project aim

The Renewable Pathways Initiative aims include:

- Facilitating the transition to renewable energy in identified communities
- Creating new job opportunities
- Empowering individuals with new skills and enhancing employment opportunities in the renewable energy sector
- Identifying pathways that will support workers across different sectors (for example construction and maintenance) to transition into the renewable energy sector.

## Deliverables

- Engagement of a Renewable Energy Transition Training Officer to undertake stakeholder engagement (clients and industry) to identify qualification pathways to transition the workforce into the renewable sector.

## Delivery

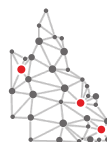
The Renewable Pathways Initiative will utilise the mobile renewable energy training facility to ensure that pilot training programs and training outcomes meet industry needs.
