

Unified Print: How to Print from macOS devices (Paperscut Print Deploy)

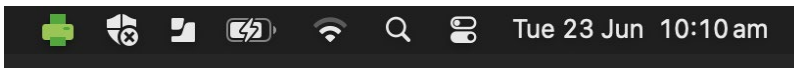


Why?

- **Paperscut Print Deploy** has been introduced to provide a print experience to match our Windows machines, on Apple Mac devices.
Paperscut Print Deploy will be deployed to all Jamf managed Macs, in the same way that the Unified Print queues are deployed to all Windows machines.

1. Check for it.

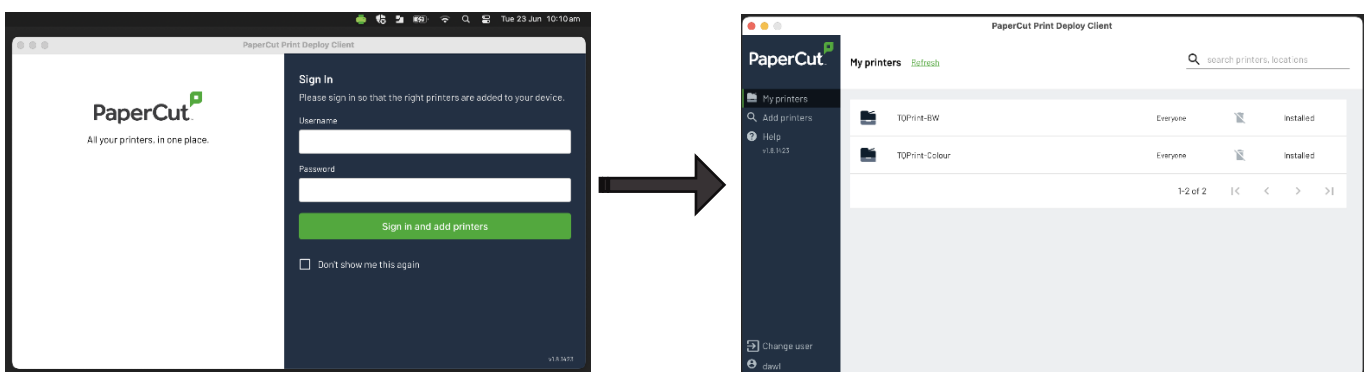
- **Look for the green printer on your Mac.**
Paperscut Print Deploy will display a green printer icon in the top notification bar when it is running.



- If it's missing, try restarting your mac, and wait at least 5-10 minutes for new software to deploy. If it is still missing after that, staff can log a macOS Support request on TAP to have it fixed.

The ticket should include the computer name, and that Paperscut Print Deploy is missing.

2. Logon to it.

- **Logon to it with your user name and your computer password.**
Use the same username and password you use to logon to your TAFE Queensland computer.



3. Print it.

- Print Deploy will tell you the printers have been **Installed**.
- Now print your Black and White jobs to TQPrint-BW and your Colour jobs to TQPrint-Colour.
- Use your ID Number or Registered ID card, to release your printing at the printer as normal.
