Role Description

We are seeking a passionate and dedicated individual to serve as a **Student Ambassador for the LGBTIQA+** student community at TAFE Queensland. This role is vital to foster an inclusive and supportive environment for LGBTIQA+ students and advocate on their behalf. Successful applicants will be positive role models in and outside of TAFE Queensland, taking collective responsibility to help others.

The role expectations may include:

- Educating others about how best to support LGBTIQA+ students.
- Helping to foster a welcoming environment where everybody feels safe and supported.
- Advocating for students on LGBTIQA+ students.
- Supporting events and initiatives for LGBTIQA+ days of significance throughout the year.
- Being visible and identifiable as the LGBTIQA+ Student Ambassador.
- Networking with/supporting other Student Ambassadors.

Out of Scope

- Acting as a counsellor or mental health support provider.
- Providing academic advice or support on assignments or assessments.
- Representing all LGBTIQA+ perspectives as a single voice—diversity within the community is acknowledged and respected.
- Being available 24/7—ambassadors are not expected to provide continuous support.
- Engaging in advocacy that conflicts with TAFE Queensland's policies or values.

Max Hours

Max 15hrs per course enrolment period noting that a student's studies are the priority.

Appointment Process

Expression of interest (EOI) is first lodged on TAFE Queensland website; a regional lead will then make contact with you to advise if you have been successfully appointed. The EOI requests a resume, contact details for two referees, start date/expected graduation date, cover letter outlining strengths, ability to use online systems, advice on communication skills, commitment availability to participate in student promotional events and other activities. An induction will be provided to all Student Ambassadors.
