Role Description

We are seeking proactive and safety-conscious individuals to serve as **Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) Ambassadors** at TAFE Queensland. This voluntary role is designed to empower students to contribute to a safer and more sustainable learning environment by promoting awareness, gathering feedback, and participating in WHS initiatives.

Successful applicants will be enthusiastic about student wellbeing, capable of engaging with peers, and committed to fostering a culture of safety and sustainability.

Role Expectations May Include:

- Contributing to the development of a safer and more sustainable TAFE Queensland environment.
- Attending local WHS committee meetings alongside staff representatives.
- Informally consulting with fellow students to gather feedback on safety and sustainability concerns.
- Promoting awareness and interest in safe and sustainable behaviours within the student community.
- Providing advice on student-led initiatives to enhance safety and sustainability.
- Networking with and supporting other Student Ambassadors.

Out of Scope:

- Acting as a safety warden.
- Providing first aid unless formally trained and certified.

Max Hours

Maximum of 15 hours over the course of the engagement period, noting that a student's studies are the priority.

Appointment Type

Voluntary

Eligibility

- Must be currently enrolled with TAFE Queensland in the [REGION] region (includes campuses such as [list campuses]).
- Must be available to participate in WHS-related activities and meetings.
- Must demonstrate an interest in safety, sustainability, and student wellbeing.

- Must be available to attend [monthly or as determined] Zoom meetings and participate in on-campus activities.

Ideal Candidate Attributes

- Passionate about creating a safe and inclusive learning environment.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Willingness to engage with peers and gather feedback.
- Ability to work collaboratively with staff and other ambassadors.
- Committed to promoting WHS and sustainability initiatives.

Position Sits With

Regional Student Voice Lead in consultation with the Regional WHS Director, Facilities Manager, or delegate.

Appointment Process

Appointment via Expression of Interest (EOI) recruitment process. Applicants must submit:

- Resume
- Contact details for two referees
- Start date and expected graduation date
- Cover letter outlining:
 - Strengths in WHS and student engagement
 - Communication skills
 - Commitment to participating in student activities that promote WHS and sustainability

An induction will be provided to all appointed Student Ambassadors.

Training Required

- Mandatory: WHS, Code of Conduct
- Optional: First Aid, Mentoring/Leadership
