Inherent Requirements

TAFE Queensland strongly supports the right of all people to pursue their studies in Dental Prosthetics.

Inherent requirements are the essential components of a course that demonstrate the abilities, knowledge and skills to achieve the core learning outcomes of the course, while preserving the academic integrity of TAFE Queensland's learning, assessment and accreditation processes. The inherent requirements are the abilities, knowledge, and skills needed to complete the course that must be met by all students. Students with a disability or chronic health condition may be able to have reasonable adjustments made to enable them to meet these requirements.

The Australian Disability Clearinghouse on Education and Training (ADCET) states: The inherent or essential requirements are those that students must pass in order to complete a course/unit/program. They are those components, which if removed or substituted would substantially impact on the learning outcomes.

TAFE Queensland has obligations under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (Cth), the Anti-Discrimination Act 1991 (QLD) and the Disability Standards for Education 2005 (Cth) to ensure that reasonable adjustments are available. Reasonable adjustment is a term used in the education and employment sectors to refer to any modification made to the learning environment, certification requirements, educational delivery or assessment method to help learners with disability access and participate in education on the same basis as those without disability. An adjustment is reasonable if it balances the interests of all parties affected. Adjustments must be reasonable and cannot compromise the academic integrity of a course. English Language Skills Requirements

To be considered for enrolment into an approved Bachelor of Dental Prosthetics course, the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) requires that graduates have met the English language skills requirements as outlined in the English language skills registration standard (2025) leading to initial registration. The Dental Board of Australia (DBA) have also outlined the English language skills registration standard that is required.

These requirements include a written declaration that English is your primary language or evidence of achievement of the minimum English language test result.

This form will only need to be completed once, even if you change your course preferences. To study dental prosthetics at TAFE Queensland, you must demonstrate that your English language skills will enable you to practice your profession safely.

Registration as a dental prosthetist with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) is dependent on successful application to the Dental Board of Australia (DBA). To support your application, the DBA may request evidence to demonstrate how you meet the English language skills requirements.

How do I meet the AHPRA English Language Skills Requirements?

To meet this standard, you must show the Board that you are competent in the English language by using one of the four pathways identified in the standard. The pathways are:

- 1. The combined education pathway: if you completed at least two years **secondary education** in English in a **recognised country** and your **qualifications** were taught and assessed in English in a **recognised country**.
- 2. The school education pathway: if you completed all or most of your **primary** and **secondary** school education in English in a **recognised country** *and* your **qualifications** were taught and assessed in English.
- 3. The advanced education pathway: if you have completed your **qualifications** *and* **advanced education** (which may also be known as tertiary) all taught and assessed in English in a **recognised country**.
- 4. The test pathway: if you are unable to satisfy one of the other pathways set out in the standard.

Test pathway results: You will need to complete an approved English Language Proficiency Test as part of your application: IELTS (academic), TOEFL iBT, PTE Academic, OET or Cambridge (C1 Advanced or C2 Proficiency at a test centre) and achieve the minimum scores outlined in the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) English language skills registration standard 2025.

Note: Test results will be accepted if they were obtained within the two years before the date you lodge your application.
