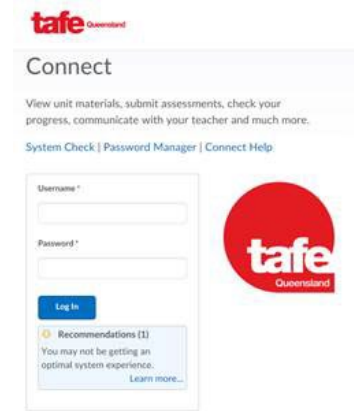


CONNECT
