If you're from a regional community impacted by drought, bushfires and COVID-19 then this program will help you build safe work practices on the farms and in the wider community.

This mix of accredited and non-accredited units will provide you with the skills and knowledge to:

- offer initial support to adults who are developing a mental health crisis and support others until appropriate professional help is received or the crisis resolves
- provide a first aid response to a casualty in a remote or isolated site over an extended period of time until medical assistance is provided
- implement standard and transmission-based precautions, and respond to infection risks in the workplace
