GAIN A **FORMAL QUALIFICATION** FULLY FUNDED



As a recipient of funding, TAFE Queensland is proud to support Construction Skills Queensland and their ongoing financial and professional contribution to the Queensland building and construction industry.

The Construction Skills Queensland (CSQ) 2023-2024 Registered Trade Skills Pathway (RTSP) program enables eligible individuals within the building and construction industry to have their existing skills recognised to gain a trade qualification (maximum one only).

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Participants of the program will undertake a skills assessment to determine any Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and gap training requirements. After your skills have been assessed via a RPL process, you must undertake a minimum of two (2) gap training units of competency to be eligible for funding.

The RTSP program is jointly funded by CSQ and the Department of Employment, Small Business and Training with no out of pocket cost, pending eligibility. Funding is paid directly to TAFE Queensland upon completion of your chosen qualification.

- CPC31020 Certificate III in Solid Plastering
- CPC31220 Certificate III in Wall and Ceiling Lining
- CPC31320 Certificate III in Wall and Floor Tiling
- CPC31420 Certificate III in Construction Waterproofing

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for funding, participants must be eligible workers in the building and construction industry in Queensland who are one of the following:

- An Australian or New Zealand citizen
- A permanent resident of Australia
- A visa holder with the right to work in Australia (excluding international student visa holders)
- 18 years of age or over
- be registered with the Department for the program
- permanently reside in Queensland or be permanently employed in Queensland

Additional eligibility requirements may apply.
