BEFORE YOU ENROL

Make sure you have submitted any documents requested before your studies.

- Your course application
- Registration from ABSTUDY (if required)
- Check your course eligibility to see what is needed, this may include:
 - Blue card / White cards / Yellow Cards
 - Vocational placement
 - Vaccinations
 - Police check
 - Uniforms / special workplace equipment

GETTING SET UP

Once you enrol you will be given information and access to our student systems and services.

- Student Portal – update your details, enrol into study units
- Student Connect – access learning materials, timetables, submit assessments or request extensions
- Student ID card – use this to access campus and concessions for local transport & activities.
- Wi-Fi – if you are studying on campus or residential block
- Library membership – get a Library card to access online library resources
- TAFE Queensland email – you will be given access when you enrol
- Video conferencing (Zoom or MS Teams) – download and pin as favourites as part of your Office 365 account
- Contact your local TAFE Queensland Indigenous Student Support Officer (ISSO)
- Identify any other Student Supports; your ISSO or Library support can help to link you up with supports like tutor, counsellor.

Tip! Keep your Student ID number and password handy to log in to all our systems.
